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Delaying care may increase the risk of health problems such as diabetes, heart disease and Alzheimer's disease.




Individuals who keep routine dental visits tend to require less extensive treatment for oral health issues.


What procedures are driving costs?

No visits




Regular visits




What types of care do people need?
